

# Recycle with the Recycling Team



## SCHOOLS ACTIVITY PROGRAMME

### WEEK 1 ACTIVITY

#### *Colouring Pages - Meet the Recycling Team*

Log onto [www.erp-recycling.it](http://www.erp-recycling.it) – click through to School page, download the Recycling Team colouring pages. There are 6 characters in the team and each have very important messages for your students. ERP suggest you detail the individual messages from each character, then pupils can colour their character of choice. We will be running competitions online later in the year and asking pupils to help us name new characters in the team.

### WEEK 2 ACTIVITY

#### *Match 2*

Working on from the kids' knowledge of the Recycling Team, the key to this game is memory! – The Recycling Team are hiding- encourage the kids to Match 2 of the characters.

### WEEK 3 ACTIVITY

#### *Online Game 1 - Wordsearch*

Download Online Wordsearch game, the task is to locate words of used household electrical items that can be recycled at your local recycling centre or a recycling event in a town in your County. This will help the kids understand what items can be recycled and build on the messages from the Recycling Team

### WEEK 4 ACTIVITY

#### *Online Game 2 – Go Recycle!*

This game is a multiple choice quiz, the pupils need to answer the questions correctly to make their journey to their local recycling centre. This will also test the pupils knowledge on the Recycling Team characters and their messages to the kids.

### WEEK 5 ACTIVITY

#### *Tina Stilo - Battery Hunt*

Encourage Pupils ask their parents to help them find used batteries at home and bring them into School. Deposit in the Battery collection box included in the Teachers Kit Pack. The challenge is for each student to locate 10+ batteries in their homes and also ask neighbours, Grannies & Grandad's for any used batteries in their homes. Remember when your battery collection box is full, you can bring it to your local recycling centre.

### WEEK 6 ACTIVITY

#### *Recyclingman– Electrical Waste Hunt*

Ask your students to make a list of household electrical items "with a plug or a battery" that can be recycled. Encourage pupils to ask their Mum or Dad to bring any used electrical items to their local recycling centre or to a Recycling event. Help Recyclingman spread his positive recycling message.
