Batteries

Support Batteries for Barretstown and recycle your used batteries free of charge with no purchase necessary at your local newsagent, supermarket or recycling centre.

WHAT CAN BE RECYCLED?

You can recycle anything that has a plug or a battery and is at the end of its useful life. Items such as:



LDA – washing machines, dryers, dishwashers, ovens



COLD – fridges, freezers



SDA – electric toothbrushes, remote controls, curling irons, wireless ear buds, battery operated toys



CRT – TVs, monitors



IT – laptops, computers, keyboards, tablets
