The European Recycling Platform (ERP) is a compliance scheme responsible for collecting and recycling waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) and used batteries in your community. We are currently running the Batteries for Barretstown School Challenge in your child's school. This programme aims to educate students on the importance of battery recycling and to increase the overall number of batteries recycled. The programme is FREE and every battery recycled contributes to a donation fund for the children's charity.

In school, your child will learn how important it is to recycle batteries, where to recycle and what happens when batteries are recycled.

How can you support the Batteries for Barretstown School Challenge?

Your child has been asked to collect used batteries at home in their battery recycling bag. This bag is biodegradable and can be reused multiple times. Please help your child collect used batteries and bring their recycling bag into school when full. The school has been fitted with a Battery Collection Tube where the used batteries can be placed.

Please remember to store all small batteries out of sight and reach of young children. See your child's battery recycling bag for safety instructions.
