Notes:

Conditions of Approval

You must comply with the conditions of approval set out in regulation 48 of the Regulations. Failure to do so may lead to enforcement action and/or withdrawal of your approval.

Validity of Approval

Your approval will cease to be valid, as stated in regulation 47(6) of the Regulations, if any of the following occur:

- A conviction of the scheme operator for an offence under—
 - (i) these Regulations (The Producer Responsibility Obligations (Packaging and Packaging Waste) Regulations 2024);
 - (ii) the 2007 Regulations;
 - (iii) the 2007 (NI) Regulations; or
 - (iv) the 2023 Data Regulations.
- The scheme operator notifies the Environment Agency that it failed to meet the obligations for the previous year of registration.
- The scheme operator failed to comply, where applicable, with any additional conditions imposed under regulation 48(2).
- There is a change in the person who is the scheme operator.

Where an approval ceases to be valid a further application for approval must be made in accordance with regulation 47, if the scheme operator wishes to continue to operate the compliance scheme.

Withdrawal of Approval

The Environment Agency may withdraw your approval, as stated in regulation 49(1), where it appears that the scheme operator:

- Is in breach of any of the conditions of approval under regulation 48.
- Has knowingly or recklessly supplied false or misleading information in connection with:
 - (i) The application for approval or registration of the compliance scheme.
 - (ii) Compliance with any of the conditions of approval.
- Is not a fit and proper person or has ceased to be a fit and proper person, to operate a compliance scheme.

Withdrawal of the approval can also occur at the request of the scheme operator.

Before your approval is withdrawn, you will be notified in writing of the decision to withdraw, the date and time when the withdrawal will take effect, the reasons for the decision and your right of appeal.
